An environmental and community regeneration charity, committed to local delivery for over 30 years.


Our vision is of a **society made up of sustainable communities which are vibrant, healthy and safe**. We deliver action for:

- » Promoting Greener Living




# Case Study 1 – The Ouseburn

- Added value through £80,000 HLF grant, community engagement and school education




# Case Study 2 – Wyke Beck

- Natural Flood Management Scheme
- Delivered in partnership
- Reduce flood peaks, enhancement of green infrastructure and allow broader engagement



# Case Study 3 – Tyne Estuary Partnership

- » Development of a new partnership
- » Estuary Enhancements
- » Environmental and economic development of the iconic Tyne Estuary
- » Over 70 sites identified, 8 priority sites
